 - 1) Chilenje House This is the house where the founding father of Zambia Dr Kenneth Kaunda lived between January 1960 and December 1962. It is from this house he directed the struggle for Zambia's independence which was finally achieved in 1964. The house is now a national monument.



2) Kabwata cultural Village – Located along Burma Road in Lusaka is a historical craft market with houses designed in a traditional African village set up. The huts were built in the 1930's and 1940's by the colonial government for single male Labourers. The 'Roundels' represent the Colonial concept of what African accommodation in town ought to have been. There are plenty of Zambia's souvenirs to find and buy, baskets, masks, drums, traditional fabrics, wood carvings and many more



3) Leopards Hill Memorial Park – This a private cemetery in the eastern suburb of Lusaka. The cemetery was created in response to the absence of a dignified burial ground within Lusaka

4) The Lusaka National Museum There you will meet resident archaeologists and Historians who will give an insight into the history of Zambia. If you are an art lover it's an exciting visit too.
