

ANABEZI – LOWER ZAMBEZI

Anabezi Lodge Lower Zambezi National Park

Day 1 - you will make your way to Lusaka Airport for a short flight to The Lower Zambezi – This flight takes approximately 30 minutes rising quickly then dropping over the Escarpment into the Lower Zambezi National Park.



On arrival at the Jeki Airstrip you will be met by Anabezi Lodge and transferred to the lodge through the park – this transfer takes about 30 minutes depending on the game viewing on route!!

Anabezi tented luxury safari camp is situated deep within the Lower Zambezi National Park, which forms part of the Lower Zambezi – Mana Pools Trans Frontier Conservation area, spanning 1,750,000 hectares of wilderness. The area is a big game mecca, an African Eden, and one of the world's last remaining untouched natural landscapes. Exceptional game viewing is assured – the area is home to a host of prestigious wildlife including lion, Leopard, Hyena and Elephant, as well as an abundance of other indigenous species.



The camp offers diverse land and water-based activity options which include mesmerizing game drives, tranquil river cruises, exciting fishing expeditions, canoe trips down the Zambezi's quiet and secluded channels, wilderness walks accompanied by an experienced scout, and spectacular birding excursions. On arrival at the camp you will be given a safety and security briefing as well as the Covid Policy for your stay.



During your 3 night stay you will discuss with your guide each evening the options for your game viewing activities for the next day – no day is the same in the Valley – a typical day would be an early morning call at 05.30 with coffee and Tea on the deck and a continental breakfast and then head off to your first activity of the day – perhaps a game drive in one of the most pristine game parks in Africa.





Day 4 you will be transferred after breakfast to the Jeki airstrip for your short flight to Lusaka for your onward journey.
