Personal groceries, fuel, drinks, airport taxes and travel insurances not included. \*Itinerary may need to be adjusted based on your intended arrival and departure flights in and out of Lusaka.

While dinners are included and will be prepared by our team, you will be required to self-cater for breakfast and lunch on most days. There will be some opportunities to eat in restaurants in some

Prior to your arrival, a complete shopping list for pantry items you might like to have during your selfdrive adventure will be provided. We will shop and stock your vehicle before your arrival to enable an easy transition from your arrival into your adventure. Grocery costs will be settled in Kwacha on collection of the vehicle.

Items like eggs, salt, oil, tomatoes, onions, potatoes are easily (and hygienically) available on from roadside vendors. Meat, dairy and refrigerated fresh vegetables will need to be purchased in advance or sourced in a town with reliable shops.

You will reliably find groceries in Lusaka, Chirundu and Livingstone and credit/debit card payments can be made. Smaller towns traditionally have informal markets where supply is seasonal and cash is required for purchases.

#### Day 1 –

locations.

Arrive in Lusaka and be met by our team who will assist you with check-in for the local flight and to relieve you of any luggage you do not wish to take on the short excursion to Livingstone. You will receive your itinerary in hard copy with necessary emergency numbers, confirmations and helpful information. Transfer to Livingstone by air.

Airport pickup and transfer – The Waterfront Hotel Dinner – enjoy a light braai (barbeque) meal on a river cruise. \*Lunch and drinks not included.

## Day 2 –

Explore the Victoria Falls and Livingstone town. \*local transportation and lunch not included. Dinner: transfer by boat to The Elephant Café for an unforgettable fine dining dinner showcasing indigenous Zambian ingredients and flavours along with a once-in-a-lifetime elephant encounter. \*drinks not included

Hotel day 1 and 2: The Livingstone Waterfront, Adventure Room \*breakfasts included



#### Day 3 –

Depart Livingstone back to Lusaka to begin your self-drive adventure.

You'll be met by our team and introduced to your vehicle for the rest of your time in Zambia. There will be an opportunity to do a bit of shopping in Lusaka before heading to Lusaka National Park for your first night of wild camping.

Our team will provide orientation around the campfire accompanied by an introduction to Zambian cuisine.

# Day 4 –

After breakfast, you will visit the Elephant Orphanage in Lusaka National Park operated by a local conservation organization, Game Rangers International.



From Lusaka National Park, you will head down the Muchinga Escarpment into the Lower Zambezi Valley to Wild tracks Campsite (3 hours drive; 4x4 required). Escorted by our team, you will meet the local headman of the Kanyangala Community en route. The Kanyangala Community School would welcome any donations of notebooks and stationery you might manage to fit into your suitcase.

Arrive at Wildtracks Campsite in the early afternoon and head out on a sunset cruise on the Zambezi river. \*Ice provided, make sure you include some sundowner beverages on your shopping list. Dinner provided.

#### Day 5 –

After breakfast, enjoy an adventure activity near your campsite. Wildtracks offers Baobab tree climbing and bushwalking.

Depart Wildtracks in the late morning and drive to Tafara Springs Campsite in Lower Zambezi National Park (roughly 4 hours drive; 4x4 required), enjoying animal sightings along the way. Enjoy sundowners in the campsite and a guided night drive in the National Park. Dinner provided.

## Day 6 –

Early morning guided walk in the National Park, the best way to immerse yourself in the incredible landscape abundant with bird and animal life.

There is some time on this day to relax and enjoy the campsite which is next to a water hole in the mountains of the Lower Zambezi National Park.

Enjoy an early evening game drive.

Dinner provided.

## Day 7 –

Pack up camp after breakfast and head through the National Park to Mpanshya in the Rufunsa District,



on the Northern boundary of the National Park. (Roughly 5 hours drive 4x4 required). Stop in Mpanshya market and experience local grocery shopping with guidance from our team. Guests are encouraged to prepare their own dinners in Mpanshya where there is grass fed beef, fresh vegetables and traditional grains and pulses available. Enjoy short walks around the campsite including a gorge with refreshing mountain spring water, teeming with rare birds and lush forest vegetation.

### Day 8 –

After breakfast, explore the community forest reserve on a hike through the hills around Mpanshya. This area boasts Miombo woodland and is the location of a fascinating regenerative landscape project run by Community Training Farm and is the flagship location for Tulukani's community-based adventure tourism products.

Enjoy a relaxing evening in the campsite and self-catered dinner.

### Day 9 –

Travel to Lusaka (3 hours; no 4x4 required), drop off vehicles and check in to your hotel for the evening. There is opportunity for more shopping, a spa, or to enjoy some night life in Lusaka. A visit to one of the local artisanal product shops or markets is a great way to round out your last full day in Zambia. The hotel will offer a concierge service to facilitate COVID travel certification.
